

Carbine- IV Course (CQB) (Force on Force)

Our CQB Course is set up for civilians, military and law enforcement officers who may be faced with having to clear a room or structure. It is geared to produce shooters with the capabilities to deal with close proximity offensive action. Due to the close proximity of the perpetrators and confined spaces of all types of buildings, entry team personnel must make split-second decisions and take appropriate actions in order to save lives. This course will prepare shooters for that situation.

This course will be facilitated with man marking rounds and firearms conversion kits from UTM provided by SMTC.



This course covers:

- Principles / Fundamentals of CQB
- Assault team members' responsibilities
- Command and Control
- Points of domination
- Sectors of fire
- Assault phases and reporting procedures
- Dynamic vs. Stealth Entry
- CQB Marksmanship
- Target discrimination
- Hallways, Stairwells, T- Intersections
- CQB procedures for 2, 3, and 4 man teams

Ammunition requirements:

- Carbine: -50 Live Rounds. For Live Fire Evaluations.
- UTM Ammo Provided by SMTC.
- Handgun: - 25 Live Rounds. For Live Fire Evaluations.
-UTM Ammo Provided by SMTC.

Prerequisites: A Passing Qualification in the SMTC Carbine-II Course(CQB Prep).

Required equipment: Iron sighted or military style optical device, magazine fed rifle, caliber .223 or higher is suitable for this course; three (3) extra magazines (min); handgun, belt-mounted holster, three (3) extra handgun magazines or speed loaders, appropriate eye, ear, knee and elbow protection; clothing suitable for weather conditions.
