Prerequisite: Graduation of formal Long Range Rifle-I or equivalent school.

1st Quarter, March. 25-26, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Known Distance Cold Weather Data Collection
- Gear Selection for cold/harsh weather

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 300 (match grade).

2nd Quarter, June 3-4, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Ballistics Review
- Mils / MOA Review
- Unknown Distance Field Fire
- Alternate Position Shooting

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 400 (match grade).

Cost: \$660. each



3rd Quarter, Sept. 2-3, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Moving Target Engagements (200-700 yards)
- Unknown Distance Qualification
- Low Light Shooting

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 300 (match grade).

4th Quarter, October 28-29, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Mil Based Holds (Known Distance)
- Mil Based Holds (Unknown Distance)
- Angle Shooting
