

Urban Sniper Course (USC)

The Urban Sniper Course is comprised of all the required materials which a special operations or law enforcement Sniper/Counter-Sniper would employ while in an urban environment. This course will allow for the usage of conventional .30 sniper rifles but students are encouraged to attend with a semi-auto .223 (M16/AR15) rifle systems which have been set up with a sniper scope system.

The course will cover:

- Urban Operations
- Counter Terror/Hostage Rescue Support Ops
- Urban Target Analysis
- Intel Gathering
- Urban Movement and Building Entry Procedures
- Urban Hide Construction
- Alternate Shooting Positions
- Angle Shooting
- Precision Range Fire at Unknown Distances (25 to 400 yards)
- Simultaneous Sniper Engagements
- Detailed Explanation of Suppressed Weapons Systems
- Detailed Explanation of Night Vision Systems



Ammunition requirements: Live - 500 (match grade).

Prerequisite: Long Range Rifle-I or Equivalent.

Required equipment: Scoped rifle w/Mildot, TMR or HORUS Vision reticle and target turrets/BDC, bipod, 20x (min) spotting scope; data and/or log book; appropriate eye, ear, knee and elbow protection; clothing suitable for weather conditions. Call the office for additional equipment requirements.

Note: This course has daily physical training exercises which are incorporated into the qualification courses of fire. Students must be in good physical condition.
