



The Sniper Sustainment Program was designed to enhance and sharpen the skills learned in SMTC or other Sniper schools. This quarterly program will provide a means of maintaining the initial skills learned in Sniper School and also teach new skill sets to enhance your capabilities. The program of instruction will be based on both, Military TTP's and Law Enforcement SOP's.

Prerequisite: Graduation of formal sniper school.

1st Quarter, Feb. 25-26, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Known Distance Cold Weather Data Collection
- Unknown Distance Field Fire in cold/harsh weather
- Gear Selection for cold/harsh weather missions
- Cold/harsh weather survival
- Field based hide construction for cold/harsh weather conditions

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 300 (match grade).
- Blanks - 6

Cost: \$660. each

2nd Quarter, May 20-21, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Ballistics Review
- Mills / MOA Review
- Moving Target Engagements (200-700 yards)
- Alternate Position Shooting
- Glass Barrier Engagements

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 300 (match grade).

3rd Quarter, July 29-30, 2017

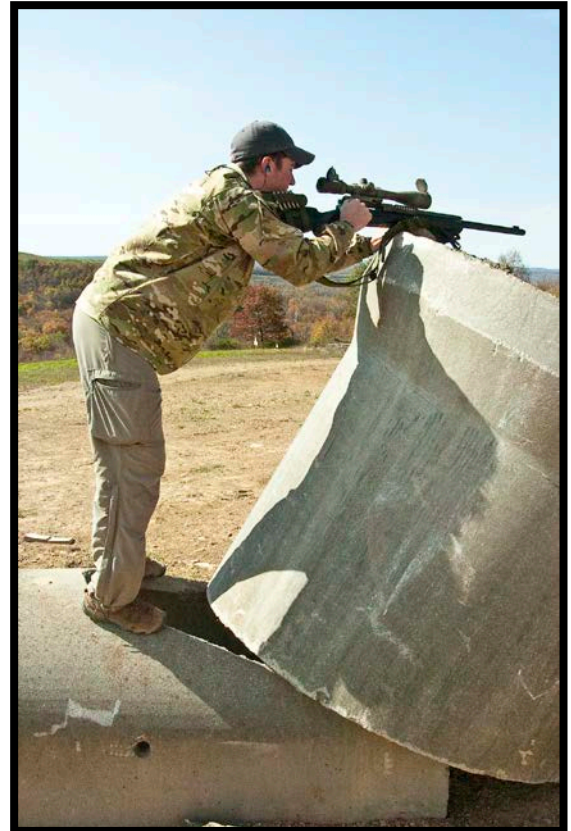
This sustainment period will cover:

- Unknown Distance Qualification
- Urban Building Entry / Climbing / Clearance
- Urban Hide Construction
- Team Based Break Contact Drills (Sniper Rifle / Carbine / Handgun)
- Low Light Sniping
- Sniper Initiated Assaults / Simo Fire

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 350 (match grade).
- CAR- 500
- HG-300

Cost: \$660. each



4th Quarter, October 6-8, 2017

This sustainment period will cover:

- Field Training Exercise (24 Hour)
- Warning / Operations Orders
- Mission Planning
- Rural Patrol Techniques
- Long Range Surveillance
- Rural Hide Construction
- Hostage Rescue Support Operations

Ammunition requirements:

- Live - 100 (match grade).

Cost: \$750. each
